



## **The Hon Justice Nahum Mushin – appointed as Adjunct Professor**

The Faculty of Law is pleased to announce that The Hon Justice Nahum Mushin has been appointed as an Adjunct Professor from 1 December 2011 until 30 November 2014.

Justice Mushin will shortly retire from the Family Court of Australia and will apply his considerable experience in the areas of dispute resolution and family law to research, occasional teaching and generally in support of the Faculty's interests and the newly formed Centre for Court and Justice Innovation. His Honour was the first Monash Law graduate to become a judge of any jurisdiction.

As one of the Faculty of Law's first undergraduate enrollees and as a long term supporter of Monash legal education, Justice Mushin's major achievements have included at various times.

- Judge with special responsibility for mediation in the Family Court involving formulation and implementation of the Court's mediation project.
- Membership of the Commonwealth Government's National Alternative Dispute Resolution Advisory Council (NADRAC).
- Leadership of the Court's consultation with the Religious Courts of Indonesia, (as part of an AusAid project with the Indonesia-Australia Legal Development Facility).
- Chairing the Court's National Cultural Diversity Committee.
- Presidential membership of the Commonwealth Administrative Appeals Tribunal.

The Faculty is very pleased to welcome Justice Mushin to its ranks and looks forward to his contributions in strengthening its approaches to the whole of dispute resolution, to teaching and to innovative research in family law.
